WHAT IS THE THRIVING CONGREGATIONS INITIATIVE?

The Thriving Congregations Initiative is a response to the reality of a shifting and ever-changing religious landscape affecting the 62 parishes of the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of Boston. Through a generous grant from the Lilly Endowment, the Metropolis is coordinating a program aimed at enhancing the vitality of its parishes and helping them thrive. The guiding principles for all curriculum and learning activities connected with this program stem from extensive research conducted by the Lilly Endowment, which found: Thriving congregations exhibit three characteristics: they understand their changing social and cultural context, have clarity around their mission and vision, and cultivate authentic Christian practices. In today's seminar, this program will highlight the first of those characteristics. In the Fall of each year, efforts will focus on education on one of the characteristics, while in the Spring. the focus will change to application of concepts learned and insights gained during the Fall.

Bill Marianes has been dubbed a "stewardship calling evangelist" and "the "Orthodox WHY guy" by the many Hierarchs, clergy, laity, and churches he has been blessed to serve. He is the founder and "Chief Evangelist" for Stewardship Calling, a totally free ministry whose WHY is: "To help people and parishes discover and live their stewardship callings so that they may have a good account before the awesome judgment seat of Christ." For the last 20+ years, Bill has crisscrossed the United States and logged well over 375,000 miles inspiring and training Parishes, clergy, and laity to understand what true Christian stewardship is, how to live their stewardship calling and reorganize and re-energize their Parishes using best practices. Bill has been blessed to lead the development of strategic plans for church jurisdictions, ministries and parishes that cover over 26% of all Orthodox Christians in America and has delivered training for well over 600+ Parishes. Prior to retiring early to start his full-time volunteer Stewardship Calling ministry, Bill was as a partner at two global law firms, McGuire Woods, and Troutman Pepper, each of which have over 1,100 lawyers. He served in management in both firms. Bill was the Managing Partner of the McGuire Woods Atlanta office and was on the Executive Committee and Head of the Technology and Intellectual Property Practice Group at Troutman. He specialized in corporate work and mergers and acquisitions. He was a lead lawyer in the creation of CNN Headline News, the Georgia and North Carolina State Lotteries, Verizon Wireless in Atlanta, and the \$3.3 Billion outsourcing technology joint venture between AT&T Global Information Services and Delta Airlines He closed well over \$10 Billion of mergers and acquisitions and outsourcing deals.

Bill has 2 Stewardship Calling live internet radio shows and podcasts on the global Ancient Faith Radio platform: (https://www.ancientfaith.com/radio/live) that air the 1st Wednesday of every month and any month that has a 5th Sunday.

Bill is also a founding member of a new, nonprofit, pan-Orthodox Christian ministry support and venture philanthropy fund, Orthodox Ministry Services who's WHY is to help transform and improve Orthodox Church organizations, parishes, and ministries in order to strengthen the Body of Christ. https://orthodoxministry.org/ Bill currently serves on the Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops Secretariat and its Legal Committee; Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America Archdiocese Council and Legal Committee; and is the General Counsel of the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of Atlanta and serves on its Metropolis Council. Bill was the Co-Chair of the 2010 Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America National Clergy Laity Congress in Atlanta.

Bill is an Archon of the Ecumenical Patriarch – Order of Saint Andrew and is a member of Leadership100. He has been awarded the Medal of Saint Paul from the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America; the medal of Saints Boris and Glib from the national Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA; and the Archangel Michael Honors award from the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of Atlanta.
